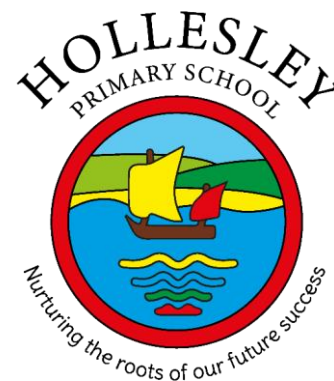

Children come into school with many different needs ranging from sleeping problems to having communication barriers. One of Mrs Elder's roles is to ensure that we are supporting children with any barriers to learning that they may have – this role is called SENDCo (Special Educational Needs and Disabilities Co-ordinator). One vital element in supporting any child is the relationship that we have with parents and befitting from the knowledge that you have

about your children. One afternoon each month Mrs Elder will be available in school for you to come and have a drink with and chat to informally about any concerns you might have and offer support where required.
