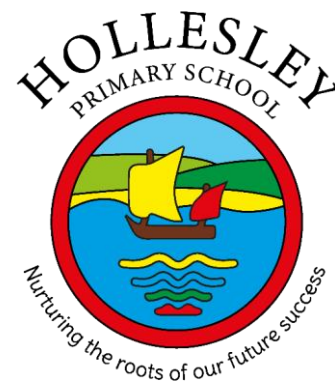

### **SCHOOL DAY**

The government's 2022 white paper laid out plans for mainstream state-funded schools to provide a 32.5-hour week, or 6.5-hour days - this ambition is still in place following the scrapping of the Schools Bill.

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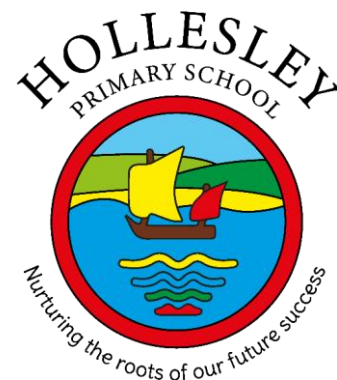
